I accept the appointment with humility and pledge my commitment to play my role together with my fellow Council members in steering this institution to greater heights of accomplishment. Allow me also to thank the members of the previous University Council led by Prof. Joachim Osur for the solid foundation they have laid for the University and for the many milestones they achieved. Our gratitude

goes to you also Sir for being our able Chancellor for a combined period of six years now. We cherish your guidance and counsel.

As a Council, we fully understand our mandate with regard to mobilizing resources and human capital with a view to realizing the vision of a leading University excelling in Technological Innovation, Research, Training and Outreach. We remain indebted to the Government for availing funds to put up key facilities that have completely changed the face of this institution since its elevation to university status in 2016. Through Government grants and

prudent resource management, we have managed to initiate and also complete a number of facilities during the last financial year, including:

- A perimeter wall along the entire University and sports field;
- Commencement of the construction of a tuition block with a 600-seat auditorium;
- Drilling of a borehole and installation of a solar pumping system; and

 Cabro-paving of internal roads and footpaths, to mention but a few.

Plans are also underway to improve the sports field with a pavilion, through a request we have made, and we look forward to receiving financial support from the Ministry for that purpose.

All these developments are in line with the 2023-2024 University Strategic Plan, whose implementation aims at addressing the long-term development of the University. The focus of implementing the Plan is to contribute to the core pillars of the Bottom-Up Economic Transformation

Agenda (BETA) and the Kenya Vision 2030 through research, innovation and technology.
